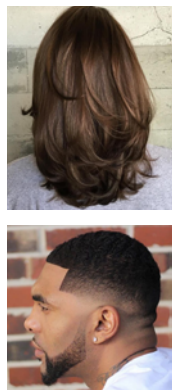

COMPOST COLLECTION AT OUR CO-OP

Saturdays • 9am-10am • Building 9 Community Room

A Co-op volunteer will collect compost from our cooperators and will be taking it to the Church of the Mediator on Saturdays.

**ONLY accepting fruit and vegetable scraps, coffee grinds, egg shells,
and tea bags. NO MEAT OR DAIRY**

Donations minimum: .25 cents per lb of compost (will go directly to Church of the Mediator)



COMPOST COLLECTION SITES NEAR BY:

Accepted items vary by site. No animal products (except rinsed egg shells) at any of the locations.

Mondays • 10am-12pm • Lehman College (outside main gate on Bedford Park Blvd & Paul Ave)

Saturdays • 10am-2pm • Meg's Community Garden (Clinton High School)

Saturdays • 10am- 12pm • Church of the Mediator (231 Street)

IMPORTANT COVID-19 Precaution measures

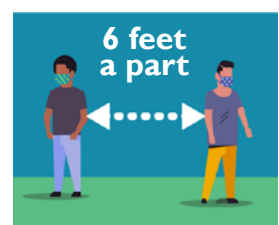
You can help to protect and safeguard your own health and the health of your neighbors.
